It features 6 self-contained learning stations with curriculum-based, hands-on activities about energy and the technologies and sciences involved with the oil and gas industry. The curriculum for each of the 24 activities is correlated to the Next Generation National Science Standards – Grades 5-8. Although the MOLU is geared to 5th grade students, it is also appropriate for other age groups.
